

# Universal Fabric Sofa Care Instructions

## Universal Fabric Sofa Care Instructions

### General Care

- Vacuum all upholstered areas weekly using a soft brush attachment to prevent dust and dirt build-up.
- Rotate and flip seat cushions (if applicable) every 2–3 weeks to ensure even wear and extend fabric life.

### Spill & Stain Treatment

- Blot spills immediately with a clean, white absorbent cloth. Avoid rubbing as it may set the stain.
- Use mild, water-based upholstery cleaners only if recommended by the fabric manufacturer.
- Avoid excessive water use, which can cause watermarks and fabric shrinkage.

### Preventive Measures

- Keep sofas out of direct sunlight and at least 12 inches away from radiators or heat vents to avoid fading and fabric damage.
- Do not use harsh chemicals, bleach, or unauthorized fabric treatments, as they void the warranty.
- Avoid sharp objects and pet claws that may snag or tear fabric.

### Cushions Care

- Rotate/flip cushions regularly (if design allows).
- Vacuum cushion surfaces and seams.
- Fluff down/feather cushions regularly; avoid prolonged heavy pressure.

### Pillow (if included)

- Vacuum pillows gently, spot clean fabric pillows as per care labels.
- Fluff and rotate pillows regularly.

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## FABRIC CLEANING CODES

### S

Spot clean only with a water-free dry-cleaning solvent. Pretest a small, inconspicuous

area before proceeding. Do not saturate. DO NOT USE WATER. Pile fabrics may require brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to restore appearance.

Cushion covers should not be removed and dry cleaned. To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming, or light brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to remove dust and grime is recommended.

When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove spilled material. Evenly

clean the entire panel in a seam to seam fashion. Do not clean just the spots or stains.

Overall cleaning by a professional furniture cleaning service only is recommended. When an overall soiled condition has been reached and professional care is required.

### SW

Spot clean with upholstery shampoo, foam from a mild detergent, or mild

dry-cleaning solvent designed for furniture. Pretest a small, inconspicuous area before proceeding. DO NOT SATURATE. Pile fabrics may require brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to restore appearance.

Hot water extraction or steam cleaning is not a recommended cleaning method. Cushion casings should not be removed and laundered or dry cleaned. To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming, or light brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to remove dust and grime is recommended.

When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove spilled material. Evenly clean the entire panel in a seam to seam fashion. Do not clean just the spots or stains.

When an overall soiled condition has been reached and professional care is required.

### W

Spot clean only with water-based shampoo or foam upholstery cleaner. Do not use

solvents to spot clean. Pretest a small, inconspicuous area for color loss and fabric compatibility before proceeding. DO NOT OVER WET.

Pile fabrics may require brushing with a non-metallic, soft bristle brush to restore appearance or reset nap. Cushion covers should not be removed and laundered. To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming, or light brushing with a non-metallic, soft bristle brush to remove dust and grime is recommended.

When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove spilled material. Evenly clean the entire panel in a seam to seam fashion. Do not clean just the spots or stains.

When an overall soiled condition has been reached and professional care is required.

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Cleaning only by vacuuming or light brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush.

DO NOT USE ANY WATER OR SOLVENT BASED CLEANER.
