Leather Sofa Care Instructions

General Care

- Dust and vacuum leather surfaces weekly using a soft brush attachment to remove dirt and oils.
- Wipe gently with a slightly damp, soft cloth. Allow to air dry naturally, never use a hair dryer or heat source.

Cleaning & Conditioning

- Use leather cleaners and conditioners approved by the manufacturer every 6–12 months to maintain suppleness.
- Avoid harsh cleaners, saddle soaps, oils, or wax-based products that may discolor or damage leather.

Preventive Measures

- Keep leather away from direct sunlight, fireplaces, and heat sources to prevent fading, drying, or cracking.
- Rotate seat cushions and pillows regularly to distribute wear evenly.
- Protect leather from sharp objects, pet claws, and spills that may cause punctures or stains.

Pillow (if included)

- Vacuum pillows gently, spot clean fabric pillows as per care labels.
- Fluff and rotate pillows regularly.

FABRIC CLEANING CODES

S

Spot clean only with a water-free dry-cleaning solvent. Pretest a small, inconspicuous area before proceeding. Do not saturate. DO NOT USE WATER. Pile fabrics may require brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to restore appearance.

Cushion covers should not be removed and dry cleaned. To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming, or light brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to remove dust and grime is recommended.

When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove spilled material. Evenly clean the entire panel in a seam to seam fashion. Do not clean just the spots or stains. Overall cleaning by a professional furniture cleaning service only is recommended. When an overall soiled condition has been reached and professional care is required.

SW

Spot clean with upholstery shampoo, foam from a mild detergent, or mild dry-cleaning solvent designed for furniture. Pretest a small, inconspicuous area before proceeding. DO NOT SATURATE. Pile fabrics may require brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to restore appearance.

Hot water extraction or steam cleaning is not a recommended cleaning method. Cushion casings should not be removed and laundered or dry cleaned. To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming, or light brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to remove dust and grime is recommended.

When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove spilled material. Evenly clean the entire panel in a seam to seam fashion. Do not clean just the spots or stains.

When an overall soiled condition has been reached and professional care is required.

W

Spot clean only with water-based shampoo or foam upholstery cleaner. Do not use solvents to spot clean. Pretest a small, inconspicuous area for color loss and fabric compatibility before proceeding. DO NOT OVER WET.

Pile fabrics may require brushing with a non-metallic, soft bristle brush to restore appearance or reset nap. Cushion covers should not be removed and laundered. To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming, or light brushing with a non-metallic, soft bristle brush to remove dust and grime is recommended.

When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove spilled material. Evenly clean the entire panel in a seam to seam fashion. Do not clean just the spots or stains.

When an overall soiled condition has been reached and professional care is required.

X

Cleaning only by vacuuming or light brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush.

DO NOT USE ANY WATER OR SOLVENT BASED CLEANER.
